The City of Grand Haven Zoning Board of Appeals has scheduled Public Hearings to gather citizen input on the following requests:

Case 26-04: A request by Dick's Towing & Recovery Inc. related to the reconstruction of a building at 321 N. 7th St. (parcel #70-03-21-305-010) subject to the following: The reestablishment of a nonconforming use of an automobile recovery and towing facility in the NMU – Neighborhood Mixed-Use District, an appeal from Sec. 40-111.05.F; a variance to allow a front yard setback of 5 ft. where the required setback must be within the build to zone of 0 to 3 ft. as defined in Sec. 40-306.12, a variance from Sec. 40-411.02.D; and a variance to allow a corner front yard setback of 14 ft. where the maximum setback must be 5 ft., a variance from Sec. 40-411.02.D

Case 26-05: A request by Jason Beecham for a variance related to a garage addition at 108 Lafayette Ave. (parcel #70-03-20-455-002), a variance from Sec. 40-301.02.A to allow a detached accessory building of 1,400 sq. ft. where the maximum detached building size in the S – Southside District is 1,000 sq. ft.
