TENT REGULATIONS

Regulated by Chapter 24 of the International Fire Code

If the request for a Temporary Use Permit includes a tent, the following regulations (at a minimum) shall apply. Note that below is a <u>summary</u> of the regulations listed in Chapter 24 of the International Fire Code. Tent requests must meet all of the regulations within Chapter 24 as determined by the City Fire Inspector. The Chapter in its entirety may be supplied upon request.

- Tents and membrane structures having an area in excess of 400 square feet and canopies in excess of 400 square feet shall not be erected, operated or maintained for any purpose without first obtaining a permit and approval from the fire code official
- A fabric inspection certification shall be provided
- Fire apparatus access roads shall be provided
- An unobstructed fire break passage-way or fire road not less than 12 feet wide and free from guy
 ropes or other obstructions shall be maintained on all sides of all tents, canopies and membrane
 structures unless otherwise approved by the fire code marshal
- Tents, canopies or membrane structures or a usable portion thereof shall have at least one exit and not less than the number of exist required by the following table:

^{*}when occupant load exceeds 3,000, the total width of means of egress shall not be less than the total occupant load multiplies by 0.2 inches per person.

- Exit openings from tents shall remain open unless covered by a flame-resistant curtain.
 - o Curtains shall be free sliding on a metal support
 - Curtains shall be of a color or colors that contrast with the color of the tent
- Exit signs shall be clearly marked and installed at required exit doorways
- Exit signs shall be of an approved self-luminous type or shall be internally illuminated
- Smoking is not permitted in tents, canopies or membrane structures. Signs shall be posted.
- Open or other devise emitting flame, fire, heat or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking device shall not be permitted inside or located within 20 feet of the tent, canopy of membrane structure
- Fireworks shall not be used within 100 feet of tents, canopies or membrane structure
- Portable fire extinguishers shall be provided
