Council thanked all of the participants in the survey and Assistant to the City Manager Ashley Latsch for compiling all of the comments that were received.


City Manager McGinnis noted that the BLP would provide a recommendation at their meeting on February 18. Council discussion could possibly be continued at the March 1 council meeting. No
