1. Highland Park Retaining Wall Replacement Plan Update

City Manager McGinnis stated the next step would be more formal with the 1st special assessment resolution on the May 3 council agenda.

2. Overnight Seawall Mooring

Mooring would be allowed on the seawall this season. The proposal was to increase the fee for overnight mooring to \$25 starting July 1.

Council was in favor of the overnight mooring fee but did not want to see any day charges. The consensus was to increase the overnight fee to \$30.


Council Member Scott said he had faith that the plan would work out.
