
**NEW BUSINESS**


**21-229** Moved by Council Member **Scott**, seconded by Council Member **Fritz**, to approve the Eagles Aerie No. 925 Entertainment Tent during the Coast Guard Festival from July 31 to August 7, 2021, from 6:00 pm to 12:00 am, with a variance to the Grand Haven Code of Ordinances Section 22-4 to allow amplified sound, and to allow the temporary use of the City alley between the parking lots during this period. This motion carried unanimously.
