Project Background

- Grand Haven Township is proposing to construct a new transmission water main to provide additional flow as their system approaches capacity
- Proposed water main will be installed in the west lane of Ferry Street between Grant Avenue and 300' south of Robbins Road
- Project is funded through the sale bonds by the Ottawa County Road Commission on behalf of Grand Haven Charter Township



Impacts to Ferry Street

- Because of water main construction, the west side of Ferry Street will be completely reconstructed including new curb and gutter and concrete approaches.
- Disturbance will generally not exceed beyond the sidewalk.
- The east side of Ferry Street will be surface milled and re paved

Project Phasing

Stage 1- Grant St Intersection

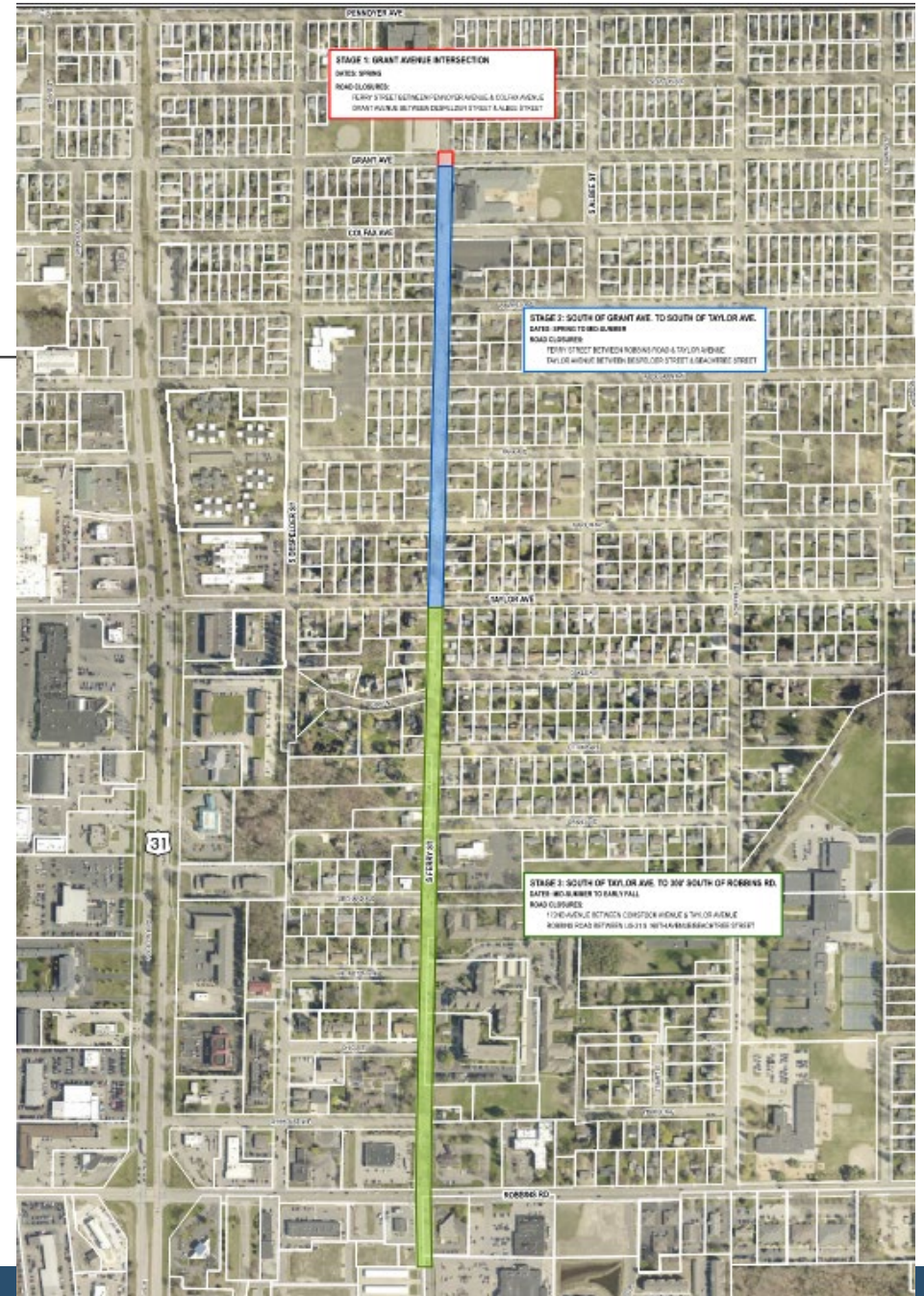
- Early April to Early May

Stage 2 - Grant St to Taylor Ave

- Early May to Mid Summer

Stage 3 - Taylor Ave to South of Robbins Rd

- Mid Summer to Fall

Construction Information

Safety: Please be aware of construction equipment and ask that residents stay out of the construction area during and after work hours.

Access: Emergency Vehicle Access to be Maintained.

- Temporary access to be maintained to residents
- There will be times where access will be limited to your home during construction – Contractor to coordinate alternate parking location

Garbage: May request trash receptacles to be placed at the road the night before.

Mail: Temporary mailbox location may be installed. Contractor to coordinate.

Construction Information

Irrigation: Please mark all irrigation heads and lines within the Ferry Street right of way.

Landscaping: Any landscaping/fencing or other improvements within the Ferry Street right of way should be removed prior to construction to prevent damage.

Drive Approaches: Drive approaches will be replaced with the same material (concrete) on the west side of Ferry Street.

Sanitary Sewer Lateral: Some Sewer laterals will be replaced from the main to the right of way line. Residents may be asked to limit use during these connections.

Water Services: The City will be replacing any galvanized steel or lead water services found during water main construction
